There is no easy way to tell you this but a daily exam of thoughts and motives will be easier with HUMILITY. It proves and improves of our love for God!

Self-condemnation does no good. I tried it. Especially after you stumble. Daily repentance is the only answer. Yes, it is humiliating going before the Lord every day but you never find judgement only encouragement.

There is joy here on earth as we invest ourselves in others for His Glory.
